**General Terms and Conditions**

1. Every applicant is required as part of their application to submit suitable plans or drawings of the proposed work, to the satisfaction of the Engineer.
2. The fee for a permit shall be as set out in the City's Building Bylaw and is non-refundable.
3. All work shall conform in every respect to the current B.C. Building Code and City Bylaws where applicable, and to the satisfaction of the Engineer, who shall have free access to all parts of the work for the purpose of inspection.
4. Prior to commencing construction, notice in writing of intent to construct shall be given to the Engineer at least seven (7) days before the work is commenced.
5. Where the work comes in contact with any culvert, ditch or other existing work, the existing work shall be maintained and supported so as not to interfere with its proper function. Where an existing work is damaged or disturbed, it shall be completely restored to its proper and original condition.
6. Where the work does not require a servicing agreement, the Engineer may require a security deposit not to exceed \$1,000.00 for each work to be constructed or altered prior to the permit being issued.
7. Where required, all excavations and materials shall be fenced, secured, signed and monitored and all other precautions taken to ensure the safety of the public. Where, in the opinion of the Engineer, the work endangers the safety of persons or property, the Engineer may, at the expense of the permit holder, require the construction of a retaining wall, culvert or other structure the Engineer deems necessary, using plans prepared by a professional Engineer.
8. Where the work has not been completed to the required specifications and standards, or City property has been damaged by the work being installed, the security deposit shall be forfeited to the City. The security deposit is not made as liquidated damages and the City may recover from the permit holder such additional costs as may be incurred in excess of the security deposit. Upon satisfactory completion of the works and compliance with the terms and conditions specified in the permit, any monies remaining from the security deposit shall be returned to the permit holder.
9. Where ownership of the completed work is assumed by the City, the permit holder shall maintain the work for a period of one year from the date of completion and the security deposit for the work shall be held by the City for that period.
10. Where an adjustment to the completed work is required due to reconstruction of the highway, the person named on this permit shall be liable for the costs incurred for the adjustment.
11. This permit may be cancelled at any time by the Engineer if, in their opinion, any aspect of the work is not being satisfactorily carried out.



By signing this Permit, the undersigned applicant accepts and acknowledges that:

1. if any employees of the applicant are regulated by the *Canada Labour Code*, due to the applicant being a federal Crown corporation or a Canadian carrier under the *Telecommunications Act*, the applicant is solely responsible to ensure the workplace and work of those employees conforms to the applicable federal statutes and regulations, and
2. in the case of all other employees of the applicant, the applicant:
  - a. is solely responsible to ensure the workplace and work of those employees conforms to the *Workers Compensation Act* (BC) and its associated regulations, as amended ("WorkSafe BC requirements")
  - b. agrees that, in respect of all matters pertaining to any work undertaken pursuant to this Permit, the person to whom this permit is issued shall be the prime contractor as defined in section 118 of the *Workers Compensation Act*, as amended, for the purposes of the WorkSafe BC requirements and shall discharge the responsibilities of the prime contractor under the WorkSafe BC requirements, and nothing in this permit shall make the City of Chilliwack ("City") the prime contractor for the site

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- c. if required will file a Notice of Project with the Workers' Compensation Board of BC prior to the start of the work; and
- d. will immediately notify the City's representative if a circumstance arises where another party claims or purports to be the prime contractor of Place of Work or Work Area, as defined on the drawing submitted to the City as part of this Permit.

The applicant must provide the City with the name of its designated on-site safety coordinator prior to the start of work and may be requested to provide a copy of the applicant's project Safety Plan. The applicant acknowledges and agrees that the applicant is fully and solely responsible for the safety of the public and those working on or near this project notwithstanding anything in this Permit.

The applicant is responsible for complying with requirements of the "Traffic Control Manual for Work on Roadways", published by the British Columbia Ministry of Transportation and Highways for regulation of vehicle and pedestrian traffic or use of roadways. The undersigned applicant represents to the City that its company, management staff, supervisory staff and workers have the necessary skills and training to comply with the WorkSafe BC requirements or in the case of a Canadian Carrier, that they will comply with and conform to all applicable federal statutes and regulations and the "Traffic Control Manual for Work on Roadways", published by the British Columbia Ministry of Transportation and Highways.

The undersigned applicant accepts and will use the road allowance and/or City-owned Land and equipment (collectively, the "Premises") at its own risk and agrees that neither the City nor its officers, employees, servants, agents, heirs, successors and assigns have made any warranties or representations respecting the suitability or condition of the Premises. The applicant further agrees that it will indemnify and save harmless the City and its officers, employees, servants, agents, heirs, successors and assigns from and against any and all claims whatsoever, including all damages, liabilities, expenses, costs including legal or other fees incurred in respect of any such claims or any actions or proceedings brought thereon arising directly or indirectly from or in connection with the granting of this Permit and use of the Premises by the applicant and its contractors, except to the extent such claims, actions or proceedings arise as a result of the negligence of the City.

The applicant will notify property owners/occupiers of interruption in service caused by the proposed works. "Interruption in service" includes utility service interruption or access constraint caused by road/lane closure. Notification must be sufficiently in advance of the work to satisfy the needs of property owner/occupiers.

The applicant will make all efforts to avoid full or partial road closures on the day of the week in which the municipal collection of waste and recycling occurs. Attached is curbside collection map indicating the days of service. In the event the closure prohibits collection of material at curbside, the applicant must relocate the curbside material to a location where the collection can occur.

The applicant will make all efforts to avoid full or partial road closures on City bus routes that adversely affect the bus route schedule or pick up location. Attached is a map showing the current City bus routes. In the event the closure is expected to delay the bus by 5 minutes or longer, the applicant must provide a traffic management plan to show an acceptable alternate route.

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The applicant shall not be entitled to any compensation including, without limitation, an extension of time or compensation for reimbursable delay in connection with or as a result of a Stop Work Order issued by the City.

The Applicant and its subcontractors shall maintain, in effect, commercial liability insurance of not less than \$5,000,000.00 per occurrence naming the City of Chilliwack as an additional insured and in a policy form acceptable to the City and automobile liability insurance of not less than \$2,000,000.00 for all owned and leased vehicles.

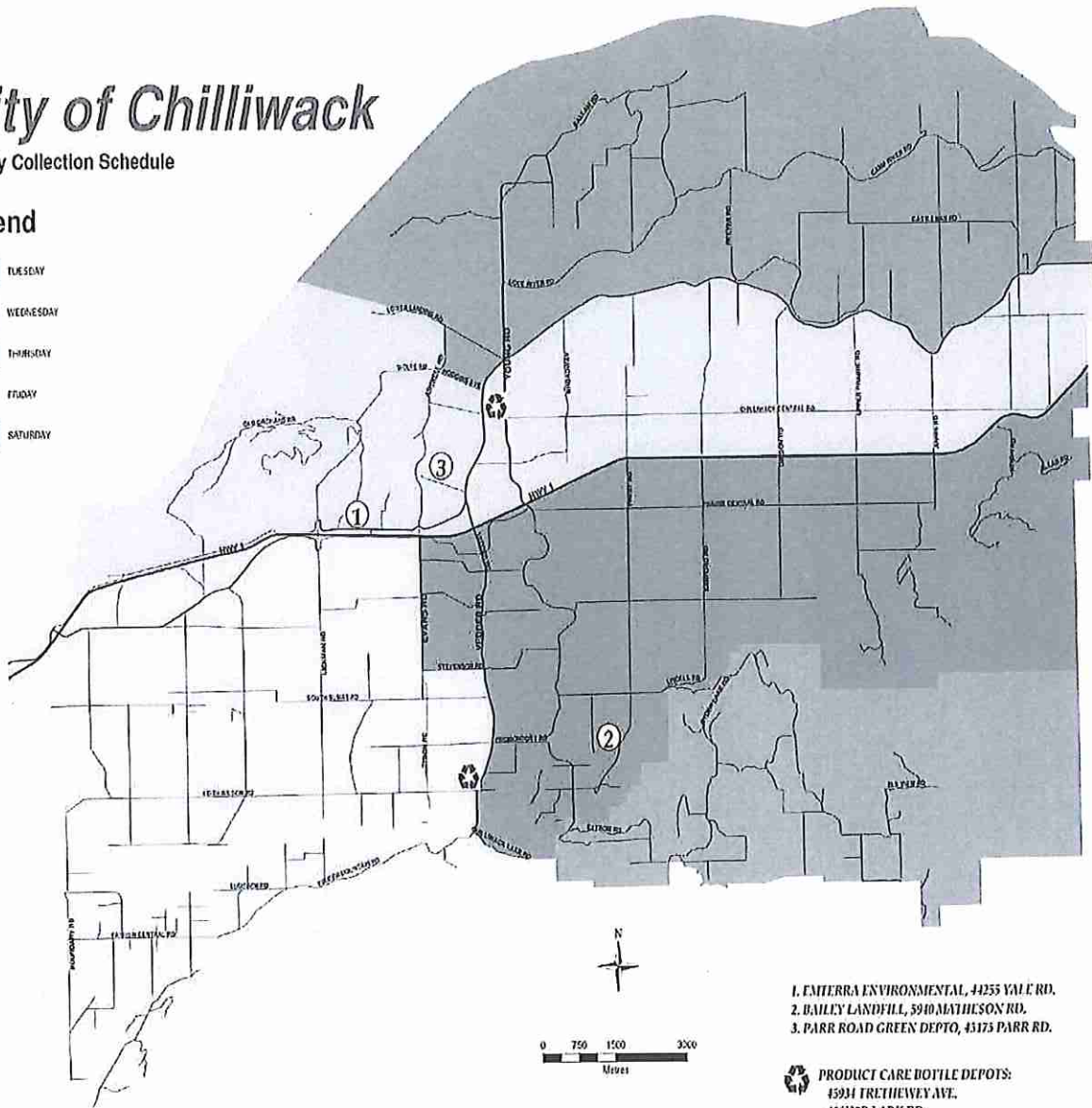
Municipal Collection of Waste (by day of week)

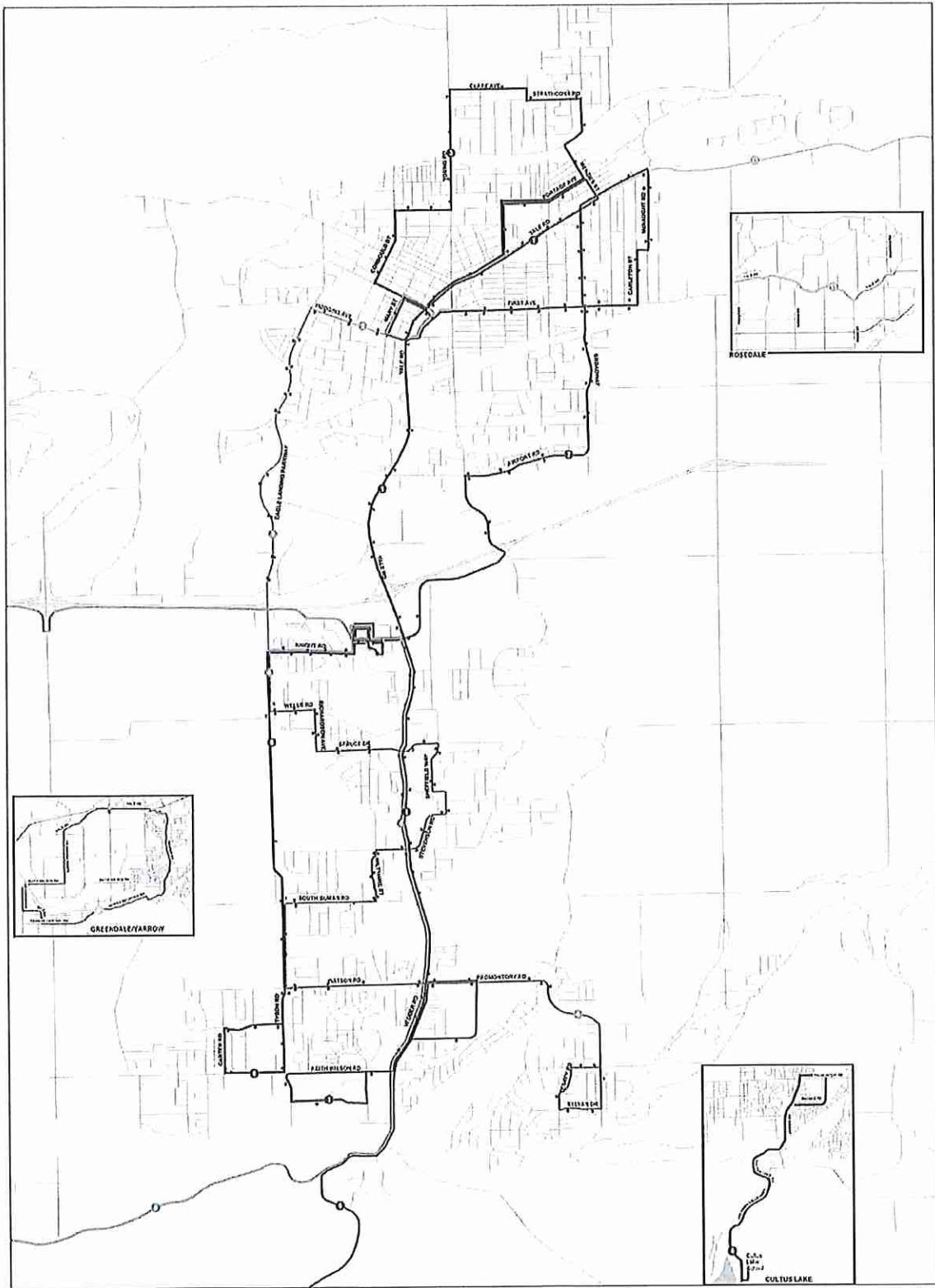

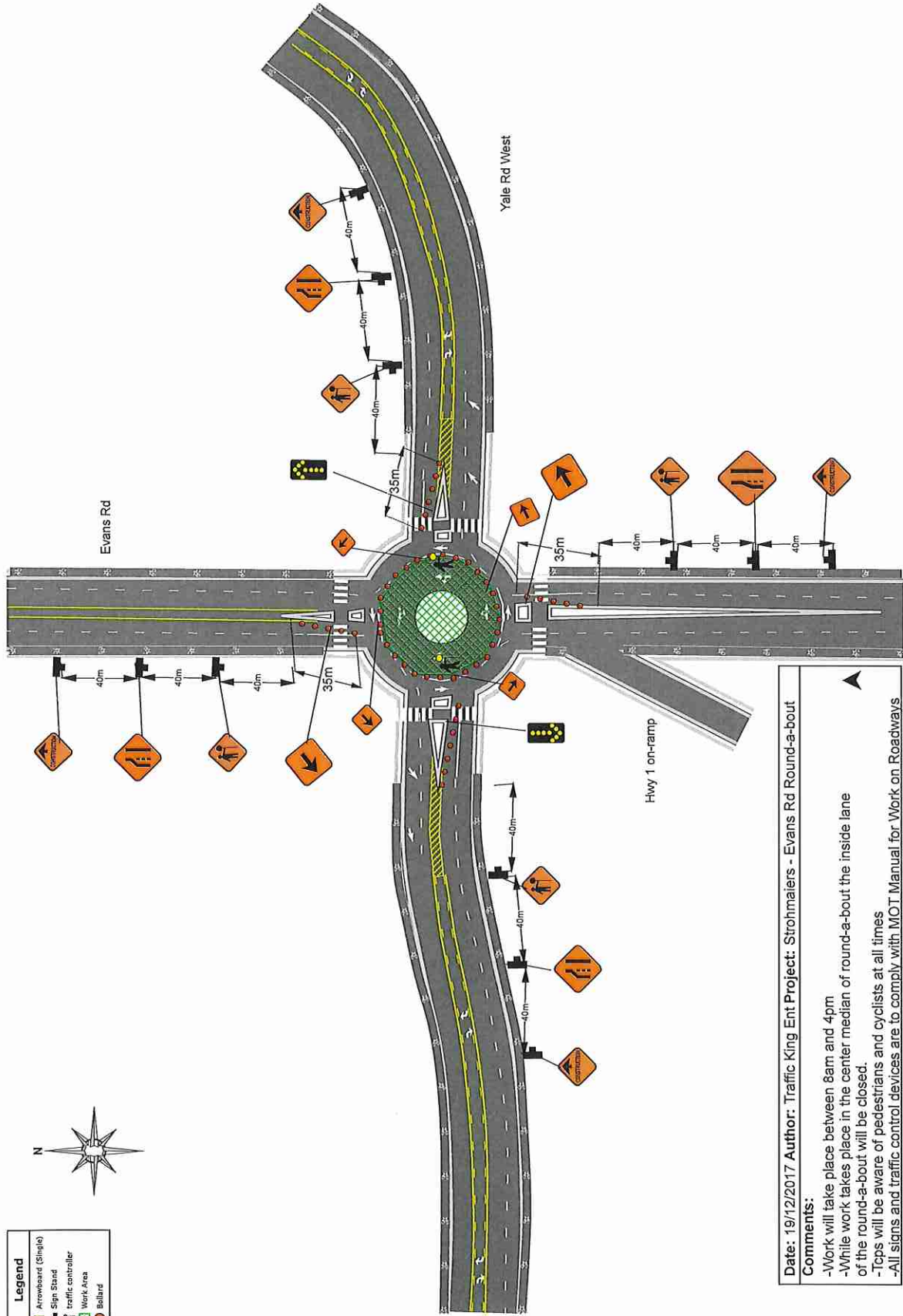

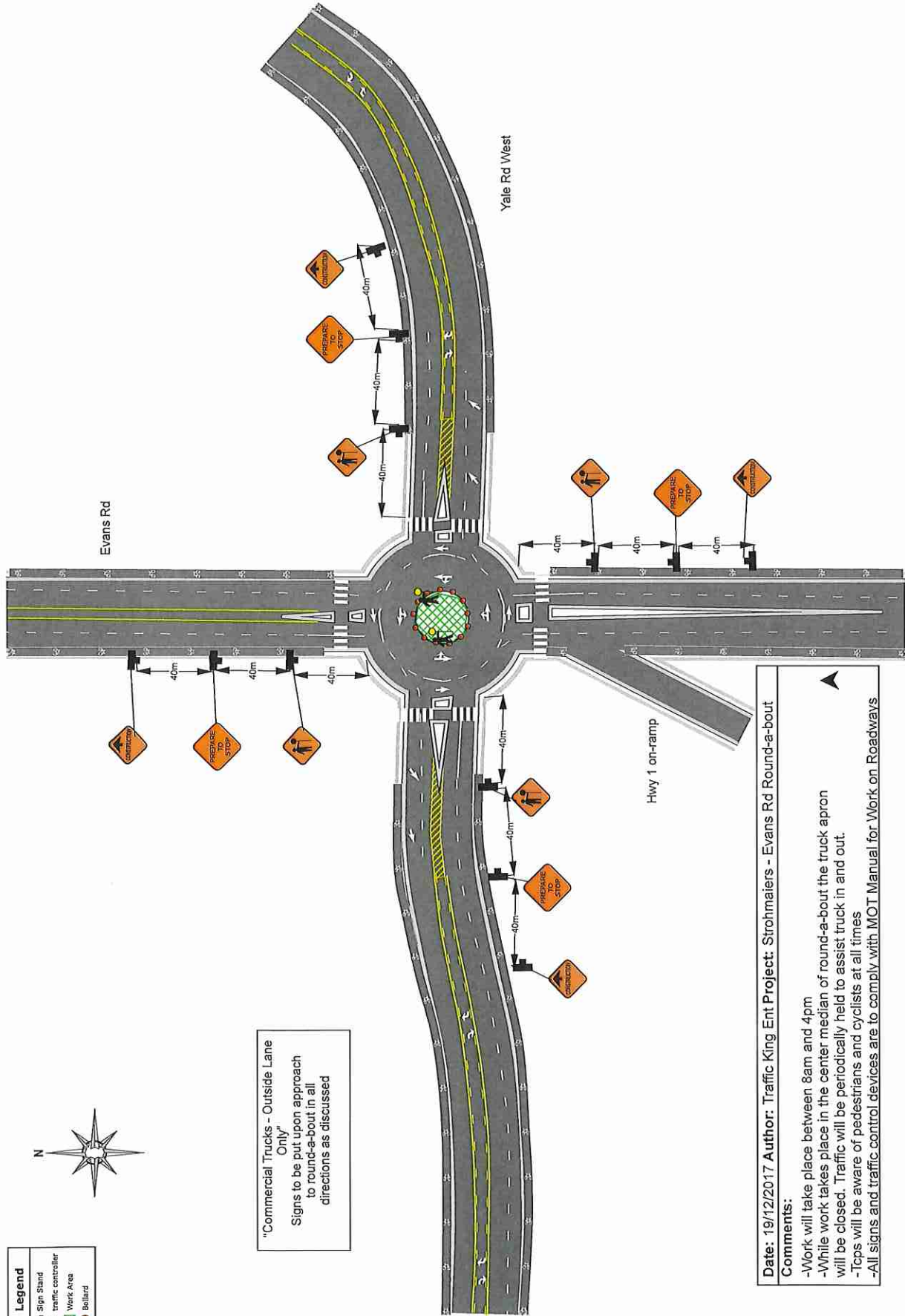
